

Revival Prayer

1. Come to God with thanksgiving and praise (personal)

3 Know that the LORD, He [is] God; [It is] He [who] has made us, and not we ourselves; [We are] His people and the sheep of His pasture. 4 Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, [And] into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, [and] bless His name. 5 For the LORD [is] good; His mercy [is] everlasting, And His truth [endures] to all generations. [Psa 100:3-5 NKJV]

- Declare that God is creator of all things and creator of humanity
- Declare that we are God's sheep and He is our shepherd, the good shepherd
- Give Him thanks for as many things as you can, especially for Jesus birth, life, death, resurrection and ascension. Thank God for the name of Jesus- the name above all other names and the only name by which we can be saved.
- Praise Him for His goodness, mercy and truth.
- Thank Him for the Church.

2. Come with humility and repentance. (Personal & Nation)

"if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land. [2Ch 7:14 NKJV]

- Confess the sins of our nation , our people, our governments and ourselves as individuals. Ask for God to forgive us.
- Pray that we seek His face to turn towards us and His grace to shine over us.
- Declare that we will turn from wickedness and ask God to help us to do that, as individuals, as a people, our governments, our churches.
- Thank God for hearing our cry and sending spiritual and physical healing for us, our church, our nation

3. Come boldly to the Holy of Holies, to find grace and help (Personal & Church)

19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and [having] a High Priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. 23 Let us hold fast the confession of [our] hope without wavering, for He who promised [is] faithful. [Heb 10:19-23 NKJV]

- Thank Jesus for His blood, His broken body and for now being our High Priest to welcome us as we boldly enter the Holy of Holies
- Thank God for the gift of faith, that we believe in our hearts that Jesus is the Son of God and God has raised Him from the dead, and because we believe in Him, we have the authority to be the sons and daughters of God (Jn1:12)

- Thank God for the blood of Jesus which cleanses our hearts of sin and for the waters of baptism, through which our old life has gone and we have been raised to new life with Jesus right now
 - Declare that faith is the substance of everything we hope for and we thank God for the gift of faith. We look forward with hope to being with God in eternity and we declare that all of His promises to us are now 'Yes' in Christ Jesus.

4. Born of the Spirit and The promised Holy Spirit. (Personal & Church)

Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." [Jhn 3:3 NKJV]

Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. [Jhn 3:5 NKJV]

"That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. [Jhn 3:6 NKJV]

- Thank God that Christians are born again, born of the Spirit.
- Ask God for a flood of people being born again

"Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high." [Luk 24:49 NKJV]

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." [Act 1:8 NKJV]

- Thank God for the promise of the Holy Spirit, the power of the Holy Spirit and the release of the Spirit on the Day of Pentecost
- Pray in the Spirit and with the gift of tongues and ask for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit without measure, at The Rock Church and in your own life.

5. Accept & declare the New Covenant (Personal & Church)

"For this [is] the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. [Heb 8:10 NKJV]

"I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. [Eze 36:26 NKJV]

- Thank God that we are now in a new covenant, where He has placed the Holy Spirit within us.
- Thank God that He is our God. He is Creator (Elohim), Almighty (El Elyon), The Source of all blessing and provision and strength (El Shaddai), He is the self existent one (Yahweh, the I Am), our healer (Yahweh Rapha), our banner in battle (Yahweh NISSI), our righteousness (Yahweh

Tsidkenu), our shepherd (Yahweh ROHI), our provider who sees our needs (Yahweh Jireh), the one who is with us always and everywhere (Yahweh Shammah)

- Thank God and ask Him to help us be His faithful people

6. Lay your requests before Him (Personal)

6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. [Phl 4:6-7 NKJV]

- Ask God for your personal needs and hearts desires

7. Ask for Boldness to preach, signs and wonders to follow (Personal & Church)

29 "Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, 30 "by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus." 31 And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness. [Act 4:29-31 NKJV]

- Ask God for boldness for all of His people and for ourselves, to preach the good news
- Ask God to stretch out His hand to heal, bring deliverance from the demonic and to release miracles.
- Ask for a mighty infilling of the Holy Spirit for everyone attending the Rock Church

8. Ask for Revival release of God's presence, fire and glory

Will You not revive us again, That Your people may rejoice in You? [Psa 85:6 NKJV]

Oh, that You would rend the heavens! That You would come down! That the mountains might shake at Your presence-- [Isa 64:1 NKJV]

When all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD on the temple, they bowed their faces to the ground on the pavement, and worshiped and praised the LORD, [saying]: "For [He is] good, For His mercy [endures] forever." [2Ch 7:3 NKJV]

- Ask God to move sovereignly, to revive our hearts so that praise and rejoicing rises to Him from the Rock Church
- Ask God to open the heavens and let His Presence come down amongst us in the Rock church
- Ask God to manifest His glory at The Rock Church, in such a way that the people bow before Him and confess His overwhelming goodness and mercy.
- Ask for His fire to burn the rubbish from our lives

9. Ask the Lord build Your church

"And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. [Mat 16:18 NKJV]

"They will come from the east and the west, from the north and the south, and sit down in the kingdom of God. [Luk 13:29 NKJV]

- Ask God to build His Church, ask Jesus to strengthen the Church, to send labourers into the harvest, to bring people from the east, west, north and south

10. Declare God's people to be added to the church (Personal & Church)

42 And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. 43 Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. 44 Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, 45 and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need. 46 So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved. [Act 2:42-47 NKJV]

- Ask God for a healthy church, where the saints devote themselves to sound doctrine and teaching
- Ask God for a revelation and embracing of taking communion together
- Ask God for a generous spirit amongst the people
- Ask God for a release of signs and wonders and favour for all of our people
- Ask God to add to the Rock Church and beyond, daily.

WAITING – after you have focused your mind by praying the Word of God above, take some time to allow the Lord to speak to you further, on any area He chooses.

- Be still and quiet before the Lord. (Psalm 46:10)
- Ask the Holy Spirit to speak to you- ‘Dear Holy Spirit, is there anything you would like to say to me just now, or anything you would like me to pray for?’
- As you wait- write down the thoughts or pictures that come. Trust that the Lord will show you the items that are from Him, for prayer.
