EMAIL YOUR LOCAL FEDERAL MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT

In that email, ensure that is nice, brief and polite, and **ask for 4 things:**

ONE

Identify that you are from their electorate. Put your contact details in the email so they can respond. Anonymous and emails from outside their electorate are usually ignored.

Find your local MP

TWO

Compliment your MP. They don't get a lot of encouragement so encourage them.

THREE

Ask for a '**Federal Religious Discrimination Bill**' – please use those four words.

FOUR

Then use this phrase 'People of faith must not be worse off because of this Bill'. The reason why you are using those words is that the Prime Minister has made that promise.

End the email politely.

How to find the email address for your Federal member of parliament-

- find your electorate by entering postcode or suburb here - <https://electorate.aec.gov.au/>
- click on the electorate name
- in the box that appears click on 'more information about the electorate of '
- scroll down to the 'current member details line and click on the 'parliament of australia' link
- this opens the members profile page.
- click on the 'connect' tab
- click on the 'email' option
- scroll to the bottom to find the email address
